


# Listen to your body, understand your symptoms

## AUB (Abnormal Uterine Bleeding)

AUB is a common symptom that leads a woman to seek gynecological advice

- Cycle length is greater than 35 days<sup>2</sup>
- ☐ Cycle length is less than 21 days³
- Heavier and increased menstrual bleeding<sup>4</sup>

#### **Fibroids Uterine Polyps**

Occur most often and become symptomatic in women aged 30 - 509

- ☐ Heavy and/or painful periods<sup>10</sup>
- ☐ Abdominal pain<sup>10</sup>
- Lower back pain<sup>10</sup>
- ☐ A frequent need to urinate<sup>10</sup>
- ☐ Constipation<sup>10</sup>
- Pain or discomfort during sex<sup>10</sup>

1 in 3 women develop uterine polyps<sup>11</sup>

- ☐ Irregular menstrual bleeding<sup>12</sup>
- ☐ Bleeding between menstrual periods<sup>12</sup>
- Heavy menstrual periods<sup>12</sup>
- ☐ Vaginal bleeding after menopause<sup>12</sup>
- ☐ Infertility<sup>12</sup>

☐ Bleeding that occurs more than 12 months after the last menstrual cycle<sup>7</sup>

Longer duration of flow occurring at unpredictable intervals<sup>6</sup>

☐ Irregular episodes of bleeding occurring outside of

☐ Erratic or irregular bleeding not associated with intrauterine pathology8

### **Uterine Cancer**

Almost 80% of women in Europe diagnosed with uterine cancer are alive five years after their diagnosis 13

- After the menopause, bleeding at any time<sup>14</sup>
- ☐ Before the menopause, bleeding
- between periods or after sex14 ☐ Non-infected vaginal discharge<sup>14</sup>
- Pain during or after sex<sup>14</sup>
- Pain in the lower abdomen<sup>14</sup>
