International Medical Corps: health worker training, including digital platforms and surge capacity



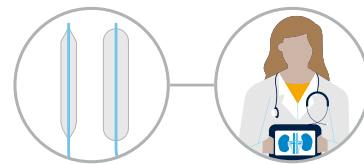
CDC Foundation: supporting rapid testing, lab capacity, workforce planning, and surge capacity

Increasing Patient Access to Medical Supplies and Products

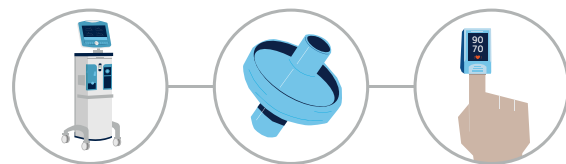
We are donating products to help a range of organizations and hospitals deliver life-saving care to patients, including:
