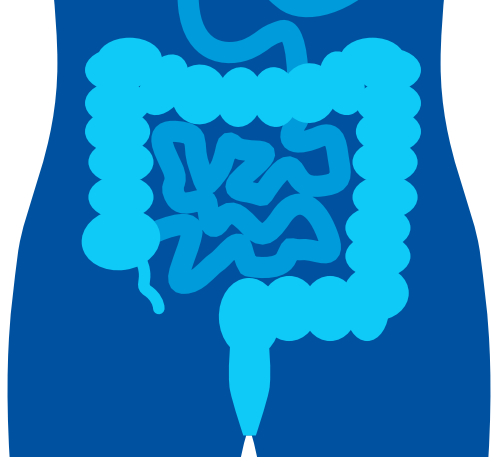

Timely screening can reduce risk of colorectal cancer morbidity and mortality.³



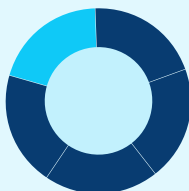
