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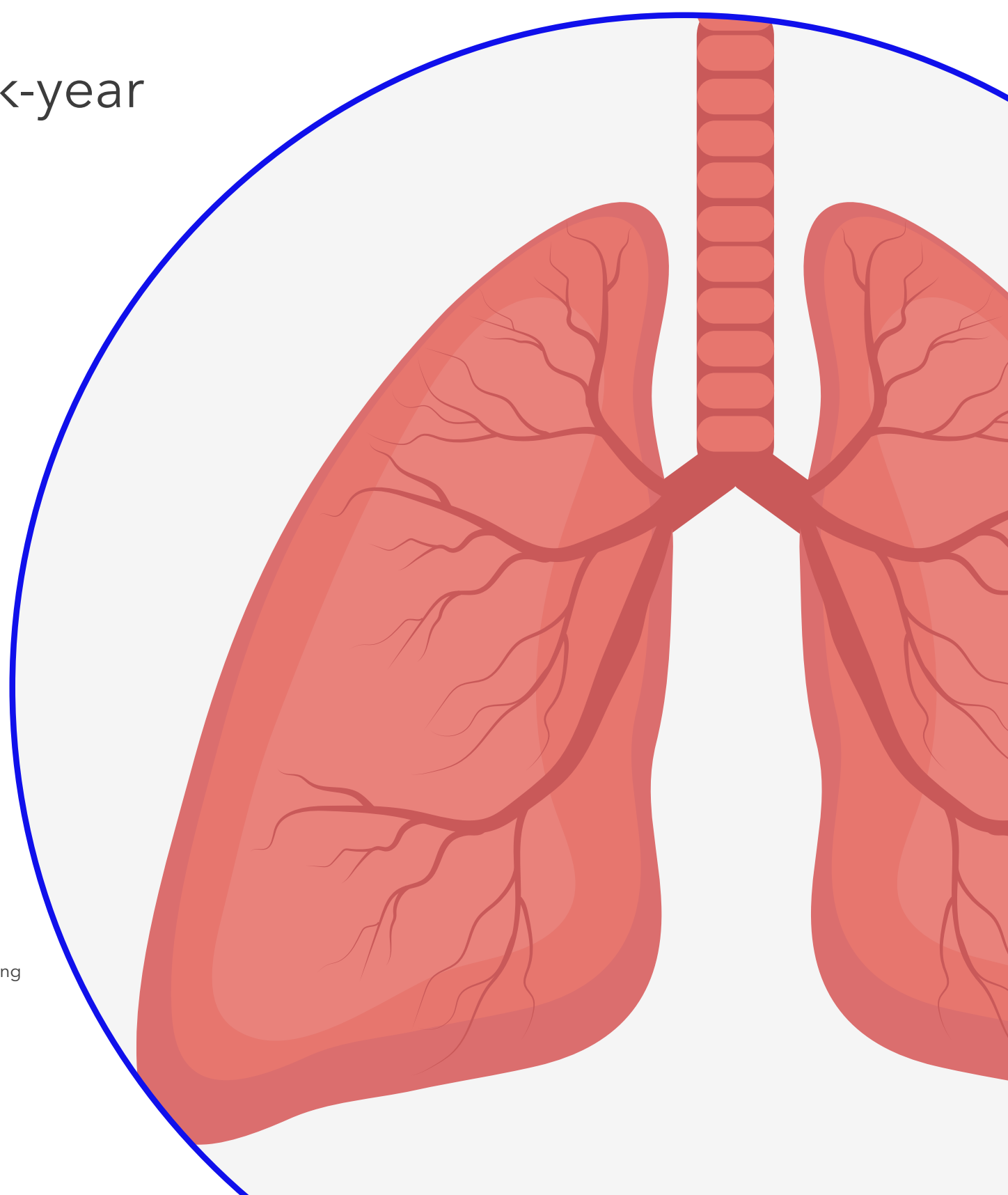
# When is the best time to get a lung screening?

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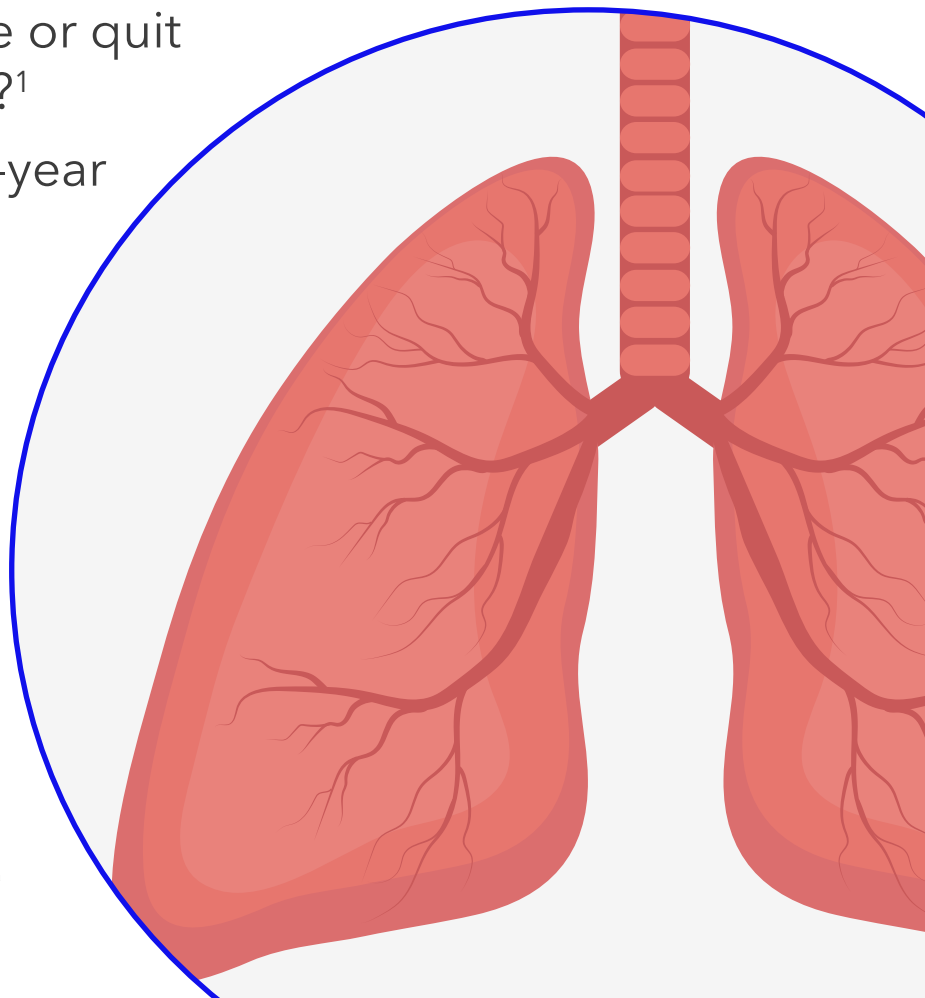
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# Are you eligible for a lung screening?
